but its main focus is on a new beloved, the appropriately named Nemesis (23, 24, 26), whom Tibullus presents as a consistently harsh and greedy mistress Where in book 1 Tibullus had imagined an idealized country life with Delia as his faithful lover, in book 2 the speaker's elegiac servitude,
